Dear Chairman Jackson:

This office represents Rio Sports Enterprises, Inc. t/a Rio Restaurant & Lounge.

Pursuant to the Rules and Regulations of the Board of License Commissioners for Prince George's County (more specifically, R. R. Nos. 36 and 37), this is to request the Board's permission for additional entertainment with specific conditions:

- A. Patron/Customer dancing on Thursdays from 10:00 p.m. to 1:00 a.m. and Fridays and Saturdays from 10:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m. with various types of music through a disc jockey ("DJ"). Rio shall not permit Go-Go or Hip-hop style music to be played;
- B. Live bands up to a maximum of two (2) performances per month for special events or functions, with patron/customer dancing permitted as part of the special event or function; Go-Go or Hip-hop style bands will not be permitted to perform;
- C. Based upon a need assessment to be performed, off-duty Prince George's County Police Officers and private security personnel will be on duty on evenings with dancing or live bands;
- D. No female dancers/adult oriented entertainment will be permitted; and


- E. Weather permitting, use of the outdoor deck between April 1 and October 31 each year between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. No outside speakers will be permitted and no outdoor music will be permitted.

Mr. Tak Yoon, on behalf of Rio and the undersigned counsel for Rio met with a few leaders of Laurel's community associations on March 23, 2010. It is the licensee's intention to continue the dialogue with the leaders of Laurel's community association up to and including the date of the hearing.

Rio respectfully requests a hearing at the Board's earliest availability/convenience.
