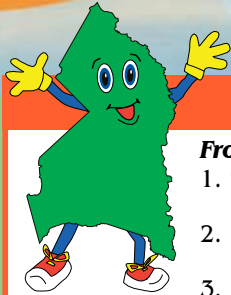

## **DIRECTIONS** (*Watch for Directional Signs!*)

### **From 495 North**

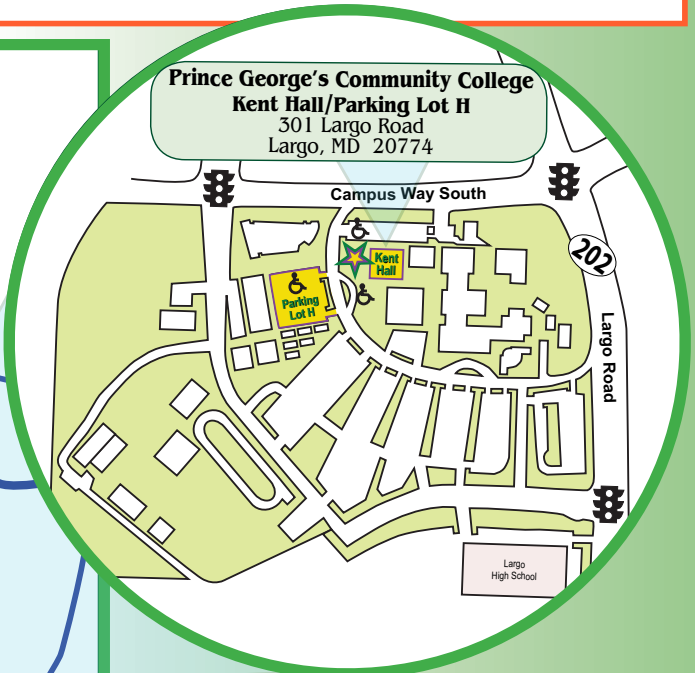
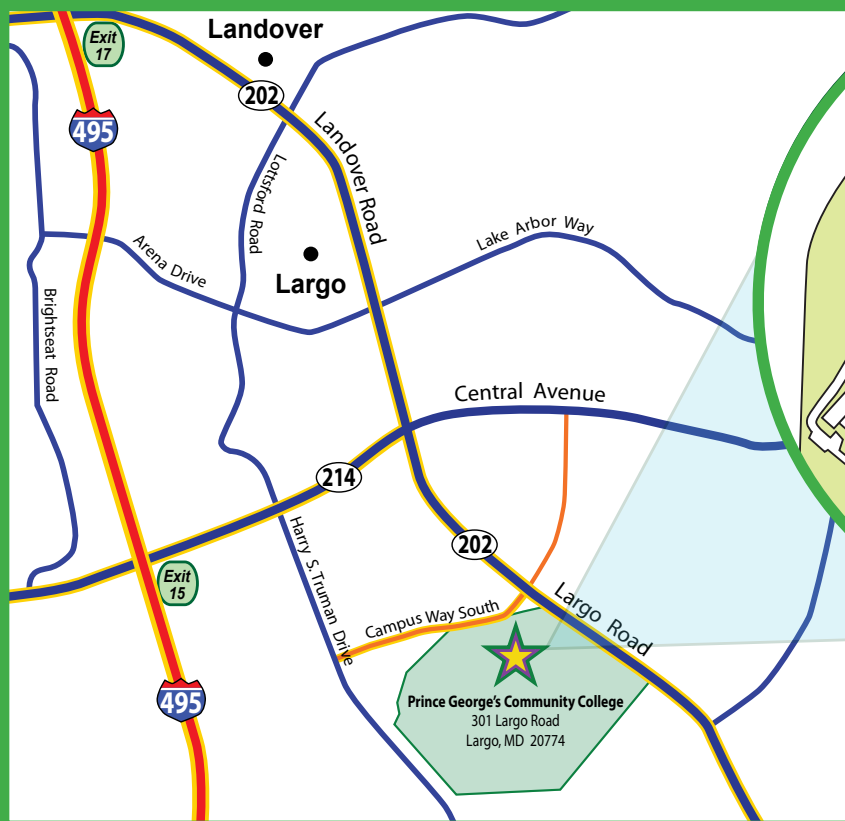
1. Take Exit 17A onto MD-202/Landover Road toward Upper Marlboro for approximately 3 miles, traveling through a total of 6 lights.
2. After the sixth light (Campus Way), Prince George's Community College will be on the right. Pass Largo Hall and Chesapeake Hall, and make an immediate right turn into the campus (this roadway has no sign).
3. Circle around to the first stop sign. **Parking Lot H** will be on your left and **Kent Hall** will be on your right.

### **From 495 South**

1. Take Exit 15 eastbound onto MD-214/Central Avenue toward Upper Marlboro.
2. Travel ~1/2 mile. After the light at Campus Way, Prince George's Community College will be on the right. Pass Largo Hall and Chesapeake Hall, and make an immediate right turn into the campus (this roadway has no sign).
3. Circle around to the first stop sign. **Parking Lot H** will be on your left and **Kent Hall** will be on your right.

### **Metro Access**

Take the Blue Line to Largo Town Center, and then take "The Bus" #21 (Upper Marlboro), #26 (MD. MVA), or the Metro Bus "C" (East Kettering) and get off at the Prince George's Community College stop. Metro and the County's "The Bus" system have additional public transportation systems to the event.
